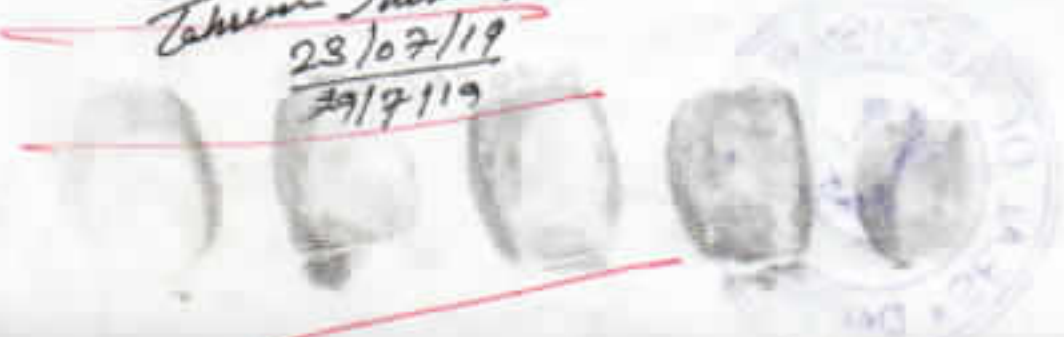

02. The name of trust shall be:

**"Manjoor Hassan Memorial Social Welfare Trust"**

03. **PLACE OF OFFICE :**

The principal place of office of the Trust is presently situated at -Rasoolpur. The trust may however open its office/sub-offices/branches at places as may be considered necessary by the board of trustees from time-to-time.

04. **OBJECTS:**

A. That the MAIN OBJECTS for which this trust is established are:

(i) To establish manage and run "**Captain International School**".

(ii) The **Captain International School**, At- Rasoolpur Allalpatti Railway Crossing Darbhanga, will be operated by Four trustees namely Tahseen Mushtaq, Shajiya Mohd Hasan Shaikh, Mohd Ehat Shamul Hak, Krishna Deo Yadav

(iii) To establish, run, support, develop, and maintain schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, universities, laboratories, research and other institutions of the like nature in India, for use of students and the staff and

for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general and to establish and run nursing homes, maternity homes, old age care centre and other specialized health service providing centre.

- (iv) To establish maintain and run studentships, scholarships and render other kind of aid to students including supply of books stipends, medals and other incentives to study without any distinction as to cast, color, race, creed, religion or sex.
- (v) To promote, establish, support, maintain or grant aid to institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music, drama and fine arts for the preservation of historical monuments and for the research and other institutions in India, having similar objects for the benefits of the public in general.
- (vi) To establish, maintain or grant aid for the establishment and maintenance of parks, gardens, gymnasiums, sports-clubs for all round development of human resources and use by public in general.
- (vii) To establish maintain or grant aid to homes for the aged, orphanages or other establishment for the relief of widows and aged persons and to educate them for better life and prosperity.
- (ix) To establish and develop institutions for the physically handicapped and disabled or mentally retired persons and to provide them education, food, clothing or other help.
- (x) To grant relief and assistance to the needy victims during natural calamities such as famine, earthquake, flood, etc. and to give donations and other assistance to institutions, establishments or persons engaged in relief work for the purpose of development and inculcation of social activity among the people.
- (xi) To grant aid or render assistance to other public educational trusts or institutions.

In furtherance of the above objects and other objects hereinafter contained in this deed the trustees may do the following acts deeds and things:

- (i) To apply the whole or part of the income or whole or part of the corpus of trust fund for one or more of the object of the trust provided that no withstanding anything hereinbefore or hereinafter contained, the income as also corpus of this Trust funds shall be applied and/or applicable only to or for such public charitable purposes and objects as define under the provisions of income tax act, 1961 and within such territories only and subjects to such conditions or limitations, if any, may from time to time be laid down in the income tax act 1961 or any other act covering taxation of income as will ensure or make the trust hereby established and income as eligible for exemption from taxation under the income tax act 1961 or any replacement or re-enactment thereof modification under any other act governing taxation for the time being in India.

(ii) **BANK ACCOUNT:**

To open account with any Bank or post office in the name of the Trust and/or in the name of the said educational institutions or other establishments and/or otherwise as may be decided by the founder trustees from time to time as the founder trustees may think necessary. Any trustee/trustees, as authorized by the founder trustees in its meeting, jointly or singly will be competent to exercise the powers contained in this clause.

- (iii) The Trustees may out of the corpus of the subject matter of the trust spend such sale/proceeds or any part thereof and appropriate such money or part thereof for laying out, erecting and furnishing and building of Educational institution, libraries, research institute or for incurring any capital expenditure as may be unanimously resolved upon by the trustees or as may be allowed by court in capital expenditure i.e. on land, construction of building, expansion and procurement major equipments etc. for the Educational institutions and/or other establishments.

- (iv) To apply for state aids, Govt. grants foreign aids whenever necessary and observe the rules and regulations that may be imposed upon them by the state Govt. and other

regulatory bodies. The object of the Trust shall not be limited by the objects as contained herein above and the trustees shall be free to do all such acts and things in furtherance of and in fulfillment of its charitable objectives directly or indirectly which are not otherwise prohibited by law. Thus Trustees may establish any business with an objective to utilize its profit only for its aims and objectives.

**C. ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES OF TRUST/TRUSTEES:**

In furtherance of the above objects and other objects hereinafter contained in this deed the role & responsibilities of the Trustees shall be as under:

- (i) To ensure that the College/School gets proper land, building, equipments, furniture and qualified staff at least as per the norms of the apex conferencing body.
- (ii) To ensure that the College/School is run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the institution in any shape whatsoever.
- (iii) To safeguard the autonomy of the principal and provide him total support except when the Principal goes against the established and clear directives laid down by the management.
- (iv) To have control over the College/School Management Committee and shall approve the budget/tuition fees and annual charges etc. for the college/ school.
- (v) To have control over any capital expenditure.
- (vi) To generate funds for the needs of the college/school whether it is recurring or non-recurring.
- (vii) To generate funds for the needs of the college/school has the basic essential facilities such as laboratory Equipments, games and sports articles and other co-curricular activities, Library Books etc.
- (viii) To ensure that the college/school is running as per the provisions of the education act/affiliation norms and is providing quality education to the children and for this to take necessary steps as per its need.

08. **POWERS OF TRUSTEES:**

That for the furtherance of the objects of the trust, the trustees shall have the following powers:

- (a) The Trustees will advise and support the office bearers to carry on day to day affairs of the trust.
- (b) To constitute different committees like selection committee, departmental promotion committees for various categories of staff.
- (c) To lay down conditions of service as per norms of NCTE/CBSE/Govt. and to approve promotion/appointment/termination of the employees as well as to grant special increments or rewards to the staffs.
- (d) To accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or in kind, from any person (s), body of persons or trust, with or without conditions.
- (e) To apply the whole or any part of the income of the trust or the trust fund or accumulations there to any one or more of the objects of the trust as the trustees in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.
- (f) To convert and deal with the trust property and/or investments for the time being.

- (g) To invest the Trust Fund in shares, stock or debentures or other securities and investments in deposits with or loans to any company, bank, firm or any other person and to alter, vary or transpose such investments, from time to time at the discretion of the trustees.
- (h) To borrow or raise or secure payments of moneys and also to lend money either with or without security.
- (i) To let out, demise any property comprising in the Trust Fund for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit.
- (j) To open account in the name of the trust/Trustees and/or institution run/conducted by the Trust with a bank, to operate such account and to give instructions to the bank and to provide for opening and operation of such account by the trustees or by a representative appointed by the Trustees.
- (k) To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceeding regarding the Trust fund.
- (l) To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person for the purpose of the administration of the trust in such manner and subjects to such rules and regulations as the Trustees to hold any fund or investment subjects to the provisions of this deed in such manner and subjects to such rules and regulations as the trustees may from time to time think fit.
- (m) To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the managements of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the trust.
- (n) To start, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscriptions or donations made by them.
- (o) To set apart and/or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the trust.

- (p) To join, co-operate or amalgamate this trust with other or others having similar or allied objects, upon such terms and conditions as the trustees may in their discretion think fit, particular having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this trust.
- (q) To settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim demand or things as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- (r) To give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organizations or trust in India which may have been established for the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institution, societies, organization or Trustees to start maintain, or carryout such charitable objects.
- (s) To borrow moneys either on the security of any property comprised in the trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents and it shall be lawful for the trustees to make such borrowings or payments of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit. To apply to the Govt., public bodies, any bank, urban, local, municipal, district, and other bodies, corporation, companies, or presents for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations gifts, subscriptions and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Govt., public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to confirm to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.
- (t) To take over or amalgamate with anyother charitable Trust, society, association or institution with similar objects.
- (u) To establish, manage organize or maintain or to maintaining any branch of the Trust or its branch with objects similar to those of this trust and to promote or carry on the affiliation or amalgamation of such other Trust with this Trust.

The Trustees shall be accountable only for such stocks, shares and funds as shall actually come into their hands and a Trustee shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, acts or omission or commission of the other Trustees, nor any banker or other person with whom the trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or kept.



10. **BINDING & RELAXATIONS:**

The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the Trustees may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating there to, Provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith of remuneration or reward to any

other employee or servant of the trust or to any member of the trust or other person in return for any service actually rendered to the trust.

11. **NUMBER OF TRUSTEES:**

BOARD OF TRUSTEES: All the trustees by whatever name called shall constitute a Board of trustees.

The number of founder Trustees shall be 4. Those whose name and other details mentioned in the beginning the Trustees shall be hereinafter referred to as founder trustees. Its remarkable that the founder Trustees can never be removed or terminated from the Trust. The founder Trustees shall constitute a Board of Trustees, which shall comprise of member as many as the founder Trustees may feel suitable including the founder Trustees and other persons co-opted or nominated unanimously by the founder trustees objections raised against one or any of the persons co-opted or nominated by one or any of the founder Trustees shall disqualify the persons for nomination or co-option. The successor of founder trustees will be stepped into shoe of founder trustee in place of present founder trustees.

The board of Trustees shall choose from among themselves the office bearers of the Trust.

There shall be following office bearers:

12. The Board of Trustees for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additional Trustees for such period on such terms as to retirement and re-appointment as the trustees for the time being considered proper. Any founder trustee if he/she incapable of discharging his duties, may at his own discretion nominate his/her legal heir, for the purpose to carry forward the responsibilities assigned to him by the Trust and the person nominated shall become the founder Trustee. Any casual vacancy in the founder trustees shall be

(ii) Resolution passed without any meeting of the trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of four-fifth trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a resolution duly passed at a meeting of trustees.

The accounting year of the trust shall be irrevocable for all times.

16. **APPLICATION OF INCOME TAX ACT** - All Clauses

herein are intended to secure exemption from Income Tax in the income of contributions and donations to the Trust and any clause or portion of this deed of trust which is inconsistent with or repugnant to the sections of the Income Tax act 1961 as amended, substituted or modified from time to time, shall be deemed to be deleted or modified with effect from the date on which the sections to which the clause or part of a clause is repugnant or inconsistent comes into torch.

17. **AMALGAMATION** - The Trustees may amalgamate the

Trust with another charitable Trust or Institution having similar objective with prior permission on the charity-Commissioner/court/any other law as may be applicable for the time being if required and The Trust can also take over the another charitable Trust or Institutions having similar objectives.

18. **Winding Up** - In the event of dissolution or winding

up of the Trust, the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed amongst the Trustees but the same shall be transferred to some other similar Trust/Organization whose objectives are similar to those of the Trust with the permission of the charity Commissioner/court/any other law as may be applicable for time being.

The Trustees shall be indemnified among all loss and liabilities incurred by them in the execution of the Trust and shall have lien over the funds and properties of the Trust such indemnify.

19. **LEGAL PROCEEDING:** The Trust may be sued in the
